## WORKSHOP REGISTRATION FORM

This hands-on class will show how to select, harvest, de-thorn, process, and cut lau hala leaves into strips for weaving. The class will end with making a simple 3-strand kūpe'e (bracelet) and start a 5-strand to finish on your own. Gail Kuba is a retired public and private school teacher, and a weaver who has been working with lauhala since 2000. She learned from gifted Kumu like Uncle Frank Masagatani, Auntie Ku'ulei Haina of Hana, Uncle Wes Sen and now Pohaku Kaho'ohanohano. Kuba is also a lei flower grower and lei maker, a kapa maker and studies lā'au lapa'au.
